The Faith of the Centurion...

Our Lord said to the centurion: "I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel." So why did this man believe so and why did the Lord single out his belief, if he was not Jewish and possibly worshipped the roman pagan idols? In our Protestant world (our American culture is one which is basically a Protestant culture) in the so called "gospel of prosperity"; belief is almost magical to people. They disassociate faith from their actions and life priorities. Faith is understood in terms of believing something, then if when you ask and do not receive what you are asking for, it simply means you have no faith or your faith is weak. You should be able to receive what you asked for! That will indicate you have faith... (not really...) Our Lord and God asked the Father three times to remove from Him the Chalice of his passion and death; three times he also submitted His will to the will of the Father with these words: "... but let your will be done and not mine." Can we conclude Jesus faith was weak or that He had no faith? Of course not.

Faith is not magic. It's not something that just appears. It is from the way we live. This is what the Lord was pointing out. The centurion showed by his words and actions the kind of man he was. So he comes to the Lord. He has a servant who is sick. He asked Him to heal him. That's all he asks; he does not ask Him to go to his house or anything else, because he knows that the Lord can heal. He tells the Lord: I'm a man under authority; I say to one of my soldiers: Do this and he does this; go here and he does go; to my slave, go and he does it." He knows that when under authority you should do what you're told. Confidence in our prayers comes from the way we live. If we don't live a righteous life, if we're not obedient, then when we pray to God, we will not have real confidence.

This soldier was under authority so he obeyed authority, and he had men under his authority, and he expected them to obey. He knew about authority; he knew about obedience. That was the way he lived his life, and since he was obedient, he had confidence even though he understood himself to be unworthy. This soldier was considered by the Jews to be a pagan. A Jew could not go into a pagan's house or he would be defiled. So the centurion didn't want the Lord to come to his house because the Lord, being a Jew would be ritually defiled. And of course, the centurion was humble enough to state this plainly. We should also mention what the holy writer of St. Luke's gospel says about this centurion. The people pleaded with Jesus for his case since he had built a synagogue for them! (Luke 7:1-10) "...This man deserves to have you do this, 5 because he loves our nation and has built our synagogue." 6 So Jesus went with them. He was not far from the house when the centurion sent friends to say to him: "Lord, don't trouble yourself, for I do not deserve to have you come

under my roof. 7 That is why I did not even consider myself worthy to come to you. But say the word, and my servant will be healed. 8 For I myself am a man under authority, with soldiers under me. I tell this one, 'Go,' and he goes; and that one, 'Come,' and he comes. I say to my servant, 'Do this,' and he does it."

Humility is not about putting our eyes down to the ground or bowing to people and saying things that appear and sound to be humble. Humility isn't what we sound like or how our eyes look. Humility is how we live. Humility is who we are. Humility is recognizing that without God we can do nothing and with God we can do everything (which by the way is faith). And we are unworthy of His love but He loves us and He will ways help us, even if we do not receive exactly what we ask with faith in our prayers.

Only those who are aware of their sinfulness are confident in their prayers. Being more aware of our unworthiness, we are more confident? Absolutely. Because the person who is aware of their unworthiness is living a worthy life, or relatively worthy, shall we say. We are all unworthy. The true Christian is living a good life, reliable, obedient, ethical, and honorable. And if you live in this way, regardless of your weaknesses and sins. God will hear your prayers, and you will feel confident that God will hear your prayers. This is why the centurion believed, because of who he was, how he lived. It's the same with us. There are things in our lives, each one of us, that are difficult. People we care about, situations that are not what they should be, and also, of course, our own sins and our own weaknesses that we wish we can be freed from. The soul knows when it does wrong. The soul knows when it has bad priorities. The soul knows when it's really lying to itself, saying it is a Christian but not living in a Christian way - perhaps going to church, giving alms and other things, but not having your absolute and only priority to be with God. The soul knows. And so when we pray and we feel lacking confidence, this is because of the way we live, of our priorities.

Let us learn from the centurion. He knew authority because he was obedient to authority, so it was easy for him to believe that the Lord, who has authority over all things, could do what He wanted him to do, even though he knew himself to be unworthy of such an honor. So when it comes to faith, true Christian faith, we must remember: We must live according to the things we say we believe, then our priorities will show our faith. That is true Christianity. Today we celebrate all the holy men and women of the Rus' Ukraine. We have indeed a great cloud of witnesses that had great faith. So many of the new Saints and Martyrs, beatified in 2001 were faced to live according to what they knew was true and suffer and die or forgo the faith and give in to betrayed what they believed in.
