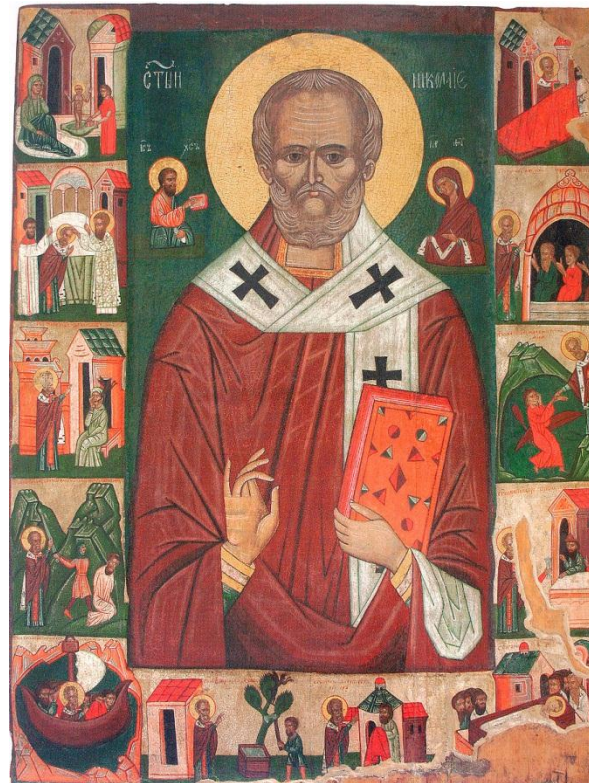

З радія "Милосердний Самарянин"

У свої проповіді з нагоди празника Св. Миколая Митр. Ігор Возняк так говорить.

Про сьогоднішнє свято, здається, знаємо багато, але мабуть, більше не знаємо, як маємо відомостей про нього. Цей святий зробив стільки чудес, допоміг стільком особам, врятував життя так багатьом людям, привернув здоров'я, встановив справедливість, витягнув з нещастя, усунув різні небезпеки, що всього ми не можемо знати й неможливо цього описати. А крім того, його духовна опіка, його святість дарована йому Богом, його любов до ближнього та Господа Бога такі значні, що людський розум збагнути не може. Бо як можна визначити, виміряти, збагнути рівень любові до ближнього, котрою палав святий Миколай? Його знає увесь християнський світ! А те, що він приходив з поміччю людям ще за життя, творячи чуда – свідчить про великий ступінь святості цієї особи.

Він жив у далекому четвертому столітті у Малій Азії, а залишається таким близьким до кожної особи з нас! Пізніше став священником і єпископом у місті Мирі, давній лійкійській провінції. Промені його світла продовжують освічувати світ, що потонув у шуканні матеріальної вигоди та легкого безтурботного життя. Він – світильник Божий, котрий приносить Господнє світло у людські душі й надихає своїм життям допомагати ближнім, котрих Господь покликав до життя на землі й вічного життя у небі. Святий Миколай відзначався надзвичайною мудрістю у використанні своїх маєтків, що йому дісталися після смерті батьків. Не був прив'язаний до багатства, навпаки, радісно виконував заклик Христа: «Якщо хочеш бути досконалим, ... продай, що маєш, дай бідним і будеш мати



скарб на небі і йди за мною» (Мт 19,21). Святий Миколай зрозумів, що найкращий спосіб збереження багатств – допомагати потребуючим, чинити милостині, бути людиною щедрої руки і милостивого серця. Він щедро роздавав потребуючим те, що посідав, а це допомагало йому йти слідом за Христом та здобувати праведність...

Послухаймо мудрих слів Товита, котрий так навчав свого сина Товію: «Роби милостиню з того, що маєш. ... Не відвертай свого лица від усякого бідного, і обличчя Боже не відвернеться від тебе» (Товит 4,7). Ми з вами

маємо багато бідних навколо себе, вони не вимагають від нас надзвичайних датків, кожна особа може положити хочаб маленьку суму в простягнуту руку, а Господь за наш приємний дар відпускає нам гріхи (пор. Сир 3,30). Може наше серце пробує осудити особу з простягнутою рукою, не дозволяймо йому робити цього, радше скажімо, можливо це потребуючий Лазар, котрому і моя скромна пожертва щастя приносить.»

Дорогі в Христі! Саме тепер у нашому деканаті маємо виграшу на потреби постраждалих у парохії «Святої родини» у Лінгурст коло Нью Йорку. Згідно з Владикою Павлом, там найбільше потерпіли. Ціна квитків 10 доларів і є можливість виграти певні нагороди, та не справа у нагородах, але у нашому бажанні допомогти потребуючим.

Як царі принесли для новонародженого Христа золото миро і кадило, принесім і ми дари для Христа, що потерпів від урагану. Хай Господь нас благословить за наше добре серце!

Святий Миколай своїм життям закликає та навчає усіх нас роздавати милостині, допомагати потребуючим, не відвертатися від тих, хто просить....

Glory to Jesus Christ! Glory Forever!

Dear _____,
(Your name here, for your very own personal letter)

I begin your letter for this week on Wednesday at noon. I've written to you on a Wednesday before, but today it's a bit special and different. As I write, it is the twelfth hour, of the twelfth day, of the twelfth month, of the twelfth year. (12-12-12) I purposely started the letter now just so I could say that! ☺ The math and number people tell us that a number like that, called a sequential number, will not occur again till the next century. So you should know what a great big part of history you are with this letter!

All around the world there are numerologists and superstitious people going kinda crazy today. The light and dark side of the inter net is extremely active these days. Some have been predicting dire things, while others have been predicting wonderful things. And all this, because of numbers and end of the calendar year.

For us, right here and now, December 12, 2012 is a beautiful winter day. Last night we had a coating of snow as a squall blew in off "the Lake." Now the temps have risen to around 40 degrees F. and the sun is shining brilliantly in a gorgeous blue sky, dotted with mounds and mounds of puffy white clouds. It is a picture perfect day in Western New York and there is nothing out of the ordinary to worry about.

As we near the year's end, each year there are always seers and prognosticators, who are easily found, and who will readily make some kind of prediction about something or other, usually a catastrophe or tragedy. This year there's a little, or maybe I should say a lot, of icing on the cake. That "icing" would be the

supposed end of the Mayan calendar causing many to speculate about the end times and get themselves and others "in a tizzy." Just in case you don't know, "in a tizzy" means in an excited and confused condition. Hah! I would say many people are always in and excited and confused condition, even without predictions!

There's a lot more today, for sure!

Anyway, a lot of people have been worrying quite unnecessarily and even wasting a lot of their valuable time here on earth wondering about things that needn't concern them. Many of these people have allowed themselves to be afraid and distracted because of all this.

Jesus addressed this question several times throughout the New Testament, but my favorite is this one: "It is not for you to know times or seasons which the Father has put in His own authority." (Acts 1:7) In other words, simply mind your own business, and don't worry about things over which you have no control. We are supposed to be leading good and righteous lives and we have nothing to fret over, no matter what happens. Baba always said, "If you're good, you don't have anything to be afraid of." Conversely, your priest says, "If you're shaking in your boots, maybe it's time for a good confession."

Recently Pope Benedict XVI, used one of his recent weekly addresses from the window of his Vatican apartment to call on all Christians, not to heed doomsday warnings. The Pope said that when Jesus was talking about the end of the world he wanted His disciples of every age (that includes you and me) not to be curious or worrisome over dates and forecasts. He calls on us to always walk the right road today, and tomorrow to enter Eternal Life. Sounds like something Baba said!

Even though there are still "Mayans," and descendants of the Mayans, in Mexico, Central and South America, their civilization basically is gone. Their "calendar" came to an end a long

time ago. Do you know any Mayans? I know I haven't seen any Mayans lately, even when we were way down south on the ship. Don't worry about this stuff. Remember our good friend, Saint Padre Pio? What was it he always said? "Pray, Hope and Don't Worry!" Pretty good advice, I would say.

If you want comfort and joy and hope, take a look at the date again. I mean the date of the writing of your letter-December 12. This day is the Feast Day of Our Lady of Guadalupe, and the remembrance of her appearances and miracles there. It's too much to write about in this letter, but her revelations to the poor Indian man, Juan Diego are astounding. In the course of several appearances, our Holy Lady requested a church to be built and as a sign to the bishop she sent roses (it was December and roses not in bloom!) wrapped in Juan Diego's *Tilma*, the cape the peasant would have worn. When Juan came to the bishop and opened the *Tilma* the roses fell to the floor, definitely convincing the bishop. If he needed any further proof of the appearances and requests of Our Lady of Guadalupe, he simply had to look at the *Tilma*. There, where the roses once were, there was now an imprint of our Holy Lady as she looked when she appeared to Juan Diego! She showed herself to be a beautiful, pregnant Indian woman, with her cape and veil surrounded by stars. Most amazing about this is the fact that when astronomers looked at the position of the stars, they realized after their study that the formation was exactly as it was on December 12, 1531!

I was going to write about a few other things, but I'll save them for now. I'm going to close for this week and pray that God willing, and the creek don't rise, I'll write again next week. Be Blessed, my Dear One!

We have so many consolations and "revelations" of heaven in our lives! I hope you can read the fascinating and beautiful story of our Lady of Guadalupe sometime. Once you do, you will not be afraid of anything. I leave you this week with the beautiful words of Holy Protection of our heavenly mother. As she asked Juan Diego, she also asks us: "*Am I not here, who am your Mother? Are you not under my shadow and protection? Am I not the fountain of your joy? Are you not in the fold of my mantle, in the cradle of my arms?*"

Our Lady of Guadalupe, pray unto God for us!

Patricia and her husband Bob had been out Christmas shopping at Toys-R-Us. They had spent well over \$200 on toys for their two children. It was already Christmas Eve and they knew that tomorrow would be an awesome Christmas for their family, as work was going extremely well for Bob and Patricia had just started her new job. As they walked out of the store, there on the curb, begging for a hand out, sat a man in his mid-thirties – about their age. The man had on a coat and a sweater and what appeared to be several layers of shirts. His face was sad looking, tattered from the harsh winter winds. All humility had left him, it was apparent. Beside him sat his daughter, probably 11. She held a cardboard sign that read: 'Homeless - Please help – Hungry'. The thing that really caught Patricia's eye though was the shopping cart filled with all their worldly possessions. It was overflowing with blankets, coats, shoes, and pants. Amongst all that dirty and shabby clothing was a teddy bear. It's face peeking out from the cart underneath a dirty brown jacket. One of its eyes was missing and it appeared to have lost some of its stuffing. Patricia guessed this teddy bear belonged to the young girl sitting on the curb, sign in hand. She imagined that it probably used to sit proudly upon a frilly lace pillow amongst other stuffed animals in the young girl's bedroom - one that was only a memory now. Patricia watched shopper after shopper walk past this humble man and his tired child, but not her husband. Bob stopped and handed the man three \$50 bills. Patricia knew it was what they had left for Christmas shopping. But that paled in comparison to what these people needed. The homeless man got to his feet and shook her husband's hand and said, "Thank you. Thank you so much. This is very generous of you. You have no idea how many people walk by and whip nickels at me and tell me to get a job or get a life. I can't thank you enough." He had a tear in his eye as he smiled at Patricia and Bob. He went on to tell her husband that he had only been homeless for a few months. How he and his daughter had moved to the area because they were told the work was plentiful. Unfortunately, things did not work out for them, they could not pay their rent, and things just went downhill

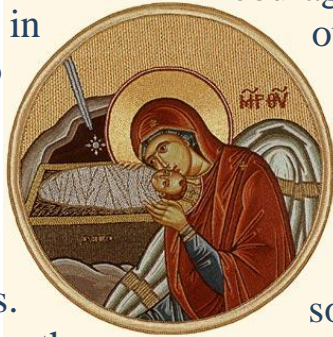
from there. Patricia and Bob invited this man and his daughter to spend Christmas with them, and later that week, Bob helped the man find a steady job. 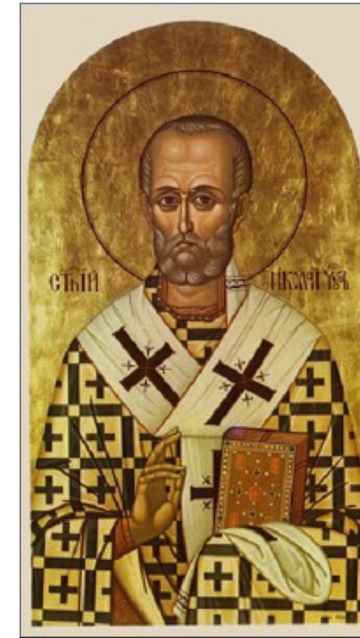
