



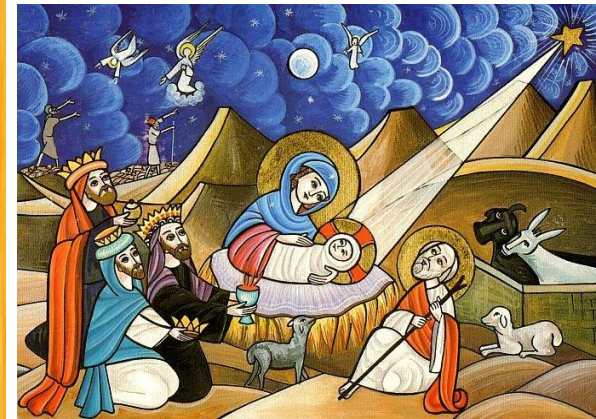

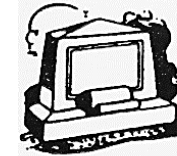

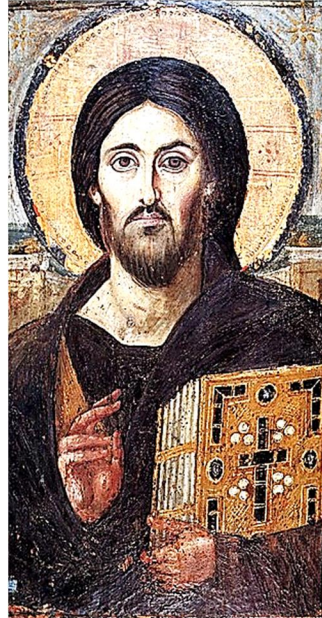

One Solitary Life

He was born in an obscure village,
A child of a peasant woman.

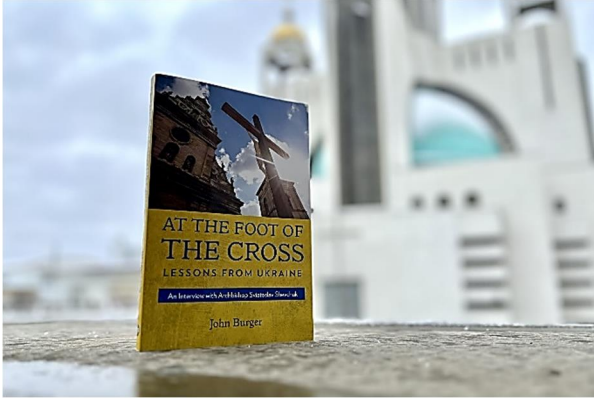

A modest effort to help understand Ukraine by John Burger

As 2023 comes to a close, I have to say: It's been an interesting year as a first-time author.

The book I began working on in 2018 was published in February:



With the Russian invasion of Ukraine approaching the one-year mark at that point, publication of *At the Foot of the Cross: Lessons from Ukraine* was quite timely.

Although Russia's war on Ukraine is tragic and regrettable, the timing of this book was interesting: the manuscript had been accepted just a month before the February 2022 invasion began.

Editions also were published in Spanish and Slovenian, and there have been a number of book reviews and media interviews.

In a thank you note, His Beatitude Sviatoslav Shevchuk, the subject of the book, told me, "I hope this book will encourage the reader to learn more about the history of our Church and our people."

The website of the Ukrainian Gr. Cath. Church carried this article about the book.

In April, I was able to present the book to Pope Francis in person.



Returning from Rome, I stopped by New Haven, Connecticut, to give a talk at the Blessed Michael J. McGivney Pilgrimage Center -- formerly the Knights of Columbus Museum -- and sign books. Later in the year, I gave the keynote address at the 90th anniversary convention of the League of Ukrainian Catholics in Buffalo, New York. The theme of the convention was "From Sheptytsky to Shevchuk: Inspiring Spiritual Leadership in Times of Crisis."

I also addressed a chapter of this organization in November in Yonkers, New York.



Finally, the Slovenian publisher Družina invited me to Ljubljana to help promote the book at the Slovenian Book Fair, around Thanksgiving. While there, I also spoke to a group of Catholic high school students about the book and did a couple of local media interviews.

So it's been a privilege to make some modest contribution to people's understanding of Ukraine. As the country continues to resist Russian aggression, I believe even more strongly that it's worth it to learn about the recent history of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church, which was suppressed for some 43 years under Soviet rule. There are troubling signs that the Church is being forced into the underground again, in areas where Russia has managed to take control.
